<p>75. wrong right</p>	<p>Mary è fidanzata <b>con</b> un simpatico giovane di Firenze. Mary is engaged <b>with</b> a nice young man from Florence. Mary is engaged <b>to</b> a nice young man from Florence.</p>
<p>76. wrong right</p>	<p>Marco è sposato <b>con</b> un'insegnate. Marco is married <b>with</b> a school teacher. Marco is married <b>to</b> a school teacher.</p>

82. wrong right	<i>Se la tua stanza non è in ordine <b>per le 8</b>, non puoi uscire.</i> If your room isn't in order <b>for</b> 8 o'clock, you can't go out. If your room isn't in order <b>by</b> 8 o'clock, you can't go out.
83. wrong right	<i>Marco non vuole uscire, preferisce <b>restare in casa</b>.</i> Marco doesn't want to go out, he prefers <b>to rest in house</b> . Marco doesn't want to go out, he prefers <b>to stay at home</b> .
