also - too - as well = *anche, pure*

Also - too - as well hanno lo stesso significato, ma sono usati in differenti posizioni nella frase.

also *Also* si mette *in mezzo* alla frase.

Prima del verbo

- > Abel not only speaks English fluently, he **also** speaks Spanish and Italian.

Dopo to be

- > Debra is not only pretty, she **is also** very clever.

Dopo un modal (can, may, must etc.)

- > Debra can play the piano, and she **can also** sing very well.

too

Too, di solito, si mette alla fine della frase.

- > Debra can play the piano, and she can sing very well **too**.

Too si usa pure *in mezzo* alla frase, ma viene preceduto e seguito da una virgola.

- > I, **too**, believe that all men are created equal.

as well

As well si mette *alla fine* della frase.

- > Tom likes beer, and he likes red wine **as well**.
