

1. either = l'uno o l'altro - uno dei due
 Excuse me. Which is the road to the airport, the one on the right, or the one on the left? You can go by either road.
<i>Invece di dire:</i> You can go by <mark>either</mark> road.
<i>si può dire:</i> You can go by <mark>either of</mark> the roads.
2. either = l'uno e l'altro - entrambi
> He kissed her on either cheek. (= on both cheeks)
Con le parole: side = (lato) o end = (estremità)
> There are always cars parked on either side of the street. On weekends there are traffic policemen at either end of the tunnel.
3. not either = né l'uno né l'altro
> Margaret likes cats and dogs, but Tom does not like either.
4. not either = nemmeno
> Lydia doesn't like football, and she doesn't like boxing either.
5. either or = o o
Margaret wants to keep either a dog or a cat.
Abel wants to spend his summer holidays <mark>either</mark> in Spain <mark>or</mark> in America.
At meal times Tom likes to drink either beer or red wine.
