Neanche io - Neanche a me*

Ci sono due modi di concordare.

a. Quando nella prima frase c'è il verbo "to be", "to have" o un *modale*, nella seconda frase si ripete.

b. Negli altri casi si usa "do/does" o "did".

1. In affermazioni positive

So am I. - So have I. - So can I. - So do I. - So did I. etc.

- I am Italian.
- **So am I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io.*

- I have got a mountain bike.
- **So have I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io.*

- I can play football.
- **So can I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io.*

- On Saturday I will go shopping.
- **So will I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io.*

- I should quit smoking.
- **So should I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io.*

- I like chocolate.
- **So do I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io. ecc.*

- Last week I went to the cinema.
- **So did I.**

= *Io pure. - Anch'io.*

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2. In affermazioni negative

Neither am I. - Neither have I. - Neither can I. Neither do I...

- I am not French.
- **Neither am I.**

= *Neanche io.*

- I haven't got a motorcycle.
- **Neither have I.**

= *Neanche io.*

- I can't sing.
- **Neither can I.**

= *Neanche io.*

- I don't speak German.
- **Neither do I.**

= *Neanche io.*

- I didn't go to the disco last Saturday.
- **Neither did I.**

= *Neanche io. ecc.*

- I don't like vodka.
- **Neither do I.**

= *Neanche a me. ecc.*

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Io sì - A me sì

- I am not tired.
- **I am.** = *Io sì.*

- I can't speak French.
- **I can.** = *Io sì.*

- I don't like beer.
- **I do.** = *A me sì.*

Io no - A me no

- I am tired.
- **I am not.** = *Io no.*

- I can speak French.
- **I can't.** = *Io no.*

- I like beer.
- **I don't.** = *A me no.*
